Dear Asbury Family,

2011 will be a year of action for us as a congregation. The 3 to 5 year strategic plans which were shared with our congregation will begin to be implemented and one of those critical goals is to retire our current building loan of \$250,000 from the almost \$2 million that we borrowed six years ago. Way to go Asbury!

Paying off this loan will enable us to move forward in many other vital areas of ministry for our church, but the question is how – how do we do it? As we have always done; through faith and sacrifice.

If 500 families give \$500 we could erase the building debt entirely.

\$84 dollars a month for 6 months reaches a goal of \$500.

So what do you think – are you with me?

Ladonna and I would like to lead the way. Sunday, February 6th is “Challenge Sunday” and our preaching staff will begin the Transform Stewardship Sermon Series that day. Ladonna and I would like to give the first \$500 on Challenge Sunday and if 100 of you will join us by giving \$500 by the end of the sermon series on March 6th, we are prepared to give another \$500. I know that some of you can give more than \$500 and I would ask that you please pray about giving an additional \$500 for an Asbury family that cannot give. I also realize that many may not be able to give \$500 to our effort so to you I simply ask you to prayerfully consider giving a sacrificial amount that will help us meet our goal.

March 6th will be our “Faith Promise Sunday” as each one of us commits to do our part to retire the building debt. The giving period will be from March 2011 to August 2011. The enclosed brochure has more information of how God can use each one of us to accomplish His will to pay off our building loan. Whether you can give \$50, \$500 or \$5,000 it will require a sacrifice from each one of us.

You have done a marvelous job in giving to retire the building loan. Even though our G3 Stewardship Campaign ended two years ago, many of you have faithfully continued to give to the building fund. Now it is time for all of us to finish the job with you!

I believe in my church home. I believe that what God does here matters and it is life changing for the hundreds who call Asbury their home. As a member of the family will you join Ladonna and I and your other church family members and finish the job God gave us?
